Production Alert:    **Highway 1 Filming Restrictions in Monterey County**

Due to the ongoing construction project on the Rocky Creek viaduct along Highway 1, Caltrans is not allowing any traffic control for filming between Post miles 54.5 and 64.5. This affects the portion of Highway 1 in Monterey County between 5 miles north of, and 5 miles south of Rocky Creek.

The construction project at Rocky Creek Bridge has a one lane section controlled by a traffic signal to allow only one-way traffic to pass at a time. This signal is creating up to 10 minute delays to traffic. Any added delay caused by additional traffic control would be negatively impact the community. Caltrans has an understanding with the community, through the Board of Supervisors, to mitigate traffic disruption in the area. The construction is expected to last through **Labor Day, 2013**.

Filming which does not hold traffic can be permitted during this period.
